Anna- This is the response I can give you at the moment. Thank you. Sarah

ORS 33.710-.720 provides a process to submit an ordinance to the Circuit Court for validation. The ordinance must first be adopted by the Board of Commissioners. I do not know at this point if the County intends to use that process related to the Second Amendment Preservation Ordinance or the Second Amendment Sanctuary Ordinance. The previous court proceedings related to the SASO were related to whether the initiative qualified for the ballot. The criteria for qualification for a ballot are very limited and don't include whether an initiative, if passed, is enforceable (constitutional, etc.). The two initiatives are very similar but I have not reviewed either recently so cannot comment on the specific differences.
